

Disassembly of ECHO suppressors

Make sure weapon is unloaded before removing suppressor.

Use the supplied tool to remove the end cap. (turn counter clockwise).

Using some type of wire hook extract baffle assembly from tube. (these are pressed together and generally stay assembled when removed). Make note on how baffles are stacked together before pulling them apart.

Clean baffles and tube as you so desire. Reassemble baffle stack and lightly oil with non flammable oil or lube. We have supplied a sample tube of froglube for you to apply before first using the suppressor . This product will help in the disassembly and cleaning process and recommend that you always lube the internals after every cleaning.

Insert baffle assembly back into tube. (Cone up)

Secure end cap. Do not use loctite!

We recommend that you completely disassemble and clean the suppressor every 300rds to ensure that future disassembly will not become an issue.
